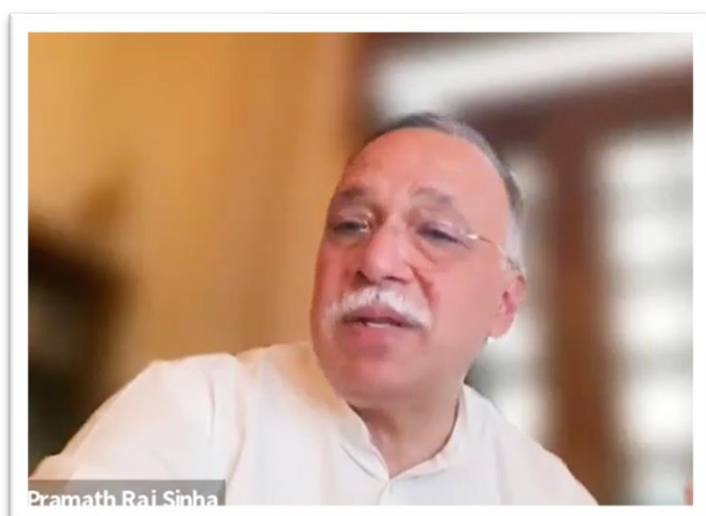
**Workshop: Shaping Future Leaders: Preparing our Students for an Unknown World
